Providing for Ongoing Needs

King Joash said to the priests, "All the... silver voluntarily given for the LORD's temple—each priest is to take it... and repair whatever damage is found in the temple..."

Then the priest Jehoiada took a chest, bored a hole in its lid, and set it beside the altar...; the priests... put into the chest all the silver that was brought to the LORD's temple. Whenever they saw there was a large amount of silver in the chest, the king's secretary and the high priest... would give the weighed silver to those doing the work... and for all expenses for temple repairs. Improving access for those with limited mobility

We provide parking for those with limited mobility in the smaller back parking lot adjacent to the building. It is across the street from our Carrera St. parking lot, and the covered walkway and pavers will facilitate access to our Welcome Center and Sanctuary.
