Cornerstone Connection: What does it mean to be a "church member"? Is it biblical? What is its value? We now have separate classes for birth through 4, Kindergarten through Grade 2, Grades 3-5, and Grades 6-up.

"Jim Lee Dinner" for Men: Our deacons host the "Jim Lee Dinner" (named in honor of one of our strong men of faith who died several years ago) this year on **Saturday, September 10**. In addition to food, fellowship, and fun, we will focus this year on discipleship for men and a new Ministry for Men. More information and sign up will begin next week.
