


For hearing aid users, we have a hearing loop installed in the Sanctuary. Activate the t-coil in your hearing aid to take advantage of this system.

NEW LIFE GROUP FORMING: Next Sunday, June 26, we will begin a new Life Group for **parents of younger children**. As our other Life Groups, it will start at 9:40 a.m. This new group will be led by Associate Pastor Wayne Husk and meet in Room 204.

VBS STARTS TOMORROW: Registration continues for this week's Vacation Bible School for children who have completed K-Grade 6! You may register online through our website or with a form in the Welcome Center. This year's theme is **Marketplace Jerusalem** and will meet Monday through Friday, 9 a.m.-noon each day. Please let your friends and neighbors know! Also, please pray for all participants and leaders. NEXT SUNDAY, our worship time will continue the "Bible Times" theme. Don't miss it!

Summer Mission Trip: Please pray for a team of 20 who will be embarking on a mission trip to Kenner, Louisiana, on **July 9-15**, working with New Hope Community Church. Our team will be working with children and doing some light construction as the church continues to recover from Hurricane Ida and COVID. The total cost is \$300 per person. Several have made donations toward scholarships for those needing assistance. Any amount you may want to give is welcomed! Simply mark your gift as "Mission Trip." All gifts will go to scholarships or for supplies that will be needed in our ministry.

Fast and Feast: On Saturday, July 2, join us for a **Solemn Assembly** from 11 am - 1 pm as we hold a **Day of Prayer and Fasting** for our church and country in our Sanctuary as we call out to God and hear readings from his Word. The next day, July 3, will be a **Day of Feasting** as we enjoy our annual July 4th Barbecue after worship.

May Financial Update: The first few months of 2022, our giving lagged behind 2021 gifts month to month, and our expenses exceeded income. For May, in what we hope is a trend, giving was up over 2021, and we had a surplus of giving over expenses. For the year to date, we have spent about \$12,000 more than we have received; God has given us generous reserves, and our Trustees continue to monitor both our giving and expenses. In a church, no one can predict gifts month to month. With COVID the past two years and with current inflation, these have been challenging times for most churches, including ours, but we are in good financial shape overall.
