OPPORTUNITIES AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

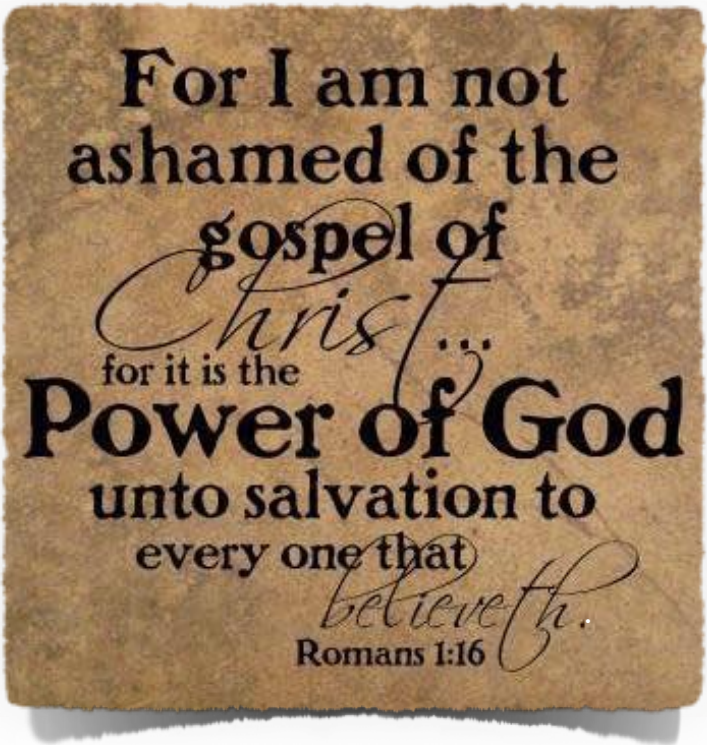
4th of July Cookout: Our annual free Independence Day fellowship meal will take place in the Fellowship Hall directly following worship next Sunday.
